DETAILED *Itinerary*



Day 0: DELHI TO PHATA | OVERNIGHT JOURNEY

- ▶ Assemble at boarding point in Delhi – Preet Vihar Metro Station and meet your Trip Captain.
- ▶ Start an overnight journey to Phata and socialize with your co-travellers.



Day 1: DEVPRAYAG SANGAM & DHARI DEVI | PHATA ARRIVAL

- ▶ Reach **Devprayag** in the morning, witness the beautiful confluence of Bhagirathi & Alaknanda rivers ultimately becoming Ganga River.
- ▶ Further we will take a halt for Freshen-up and have breakfast and continuing our journey to Phata. (Seek blessings at Dhari Devi Temple on the way if time permits).
- ▶ Upon arrival in **Phata**, check in to our comfortable accommodation, unwind and refresh yourself and have some leisure.
- ▶ In the evening, assemble in the common area for an informative **Kedarnath Yatra** briefing to ensure a smooth and well-organized pilgrimage experience.
- ▶ Relish a delicious dinner followed by a comfortable overnight stay.



Day 2: DRIVE FROM PHATA TO SONPRAYAG | KEDARNATH TREK

- ▶ Wake up early (around 3:00 AM) and, after freshening up and Have Breakfast, Later proceed with your drive from Phata to Sonprayag to avoid long queues and traffic congestion. **(Note:** Packed Breakfast options also available).
- ▶ Proceed towards Registration Verification Block at Sonprayag (Verification of your Registration take place at this point).
- ▶ Later Proceed to Gaurikund, the starting point of your trek to Kedarnath Temple **(Note:** From Sonprayag, you will need to take local transport to reach Gaurikund (at your own expense).
- ▶ Start your **22kms trek to Kedarnath Temple**, soaking in the sacred atmosphere while admiring the breathtaking Himalayan landscapes along the way.
- ▶ Upon reaching Kedarnath Temple by late evening, seek divine blessings, attend the serene evening aarti, and immerse yourself in the temple's sacred and uplifting aura.
- ▶ Check-in to our Guesthouse and have some Rest. (Note: We will Provide you sharing basis Room near Kedarnath Temple instead of Camp/Tent).



Day 3: TREK DOWN TO GAURIKUND | PHATA ARRIVAL

- ▶ Wake up early in the morning to visit **Kedarnath Temple**. Seek divine blessings at one of the most revered shrines dedicated to Lord Shiva and one of the sacred 12 Jyotirlingas.
- ▶ After completing your darshan between 7:00 – 8:00 AM and enjoying breakfast, begin your descent trek towards **Gaurikund**.
- ▶ After Reaching at Sonprayag Drive to Phata (Note: We will have to wait at Sonprayag until all the trip members assemble, as we have to continue our journey towards phata together at a same time.)
- ▶ After arriving in Phata, check-in to our accomodation and have some leisure.
- ▶ •Have dinner, followed by a comfortable overnight stay.



Day 4: DEPART FROM PHATA TO DELHI VIA RISHIKESH

- ▶ Wake up to a beautiful mountain morning and, after breakfast, drive from Phata
- ▶ If time permits, after arriving in **Rishikesh**, self-explore the **local market, Ram Jhula & Lakshman Jhula**, go for the cafe-hopping, and visit temples and serene Ganga ghats by walking.
- ▶ By late night, start your overnight journey from Rishikesh to Delhi.

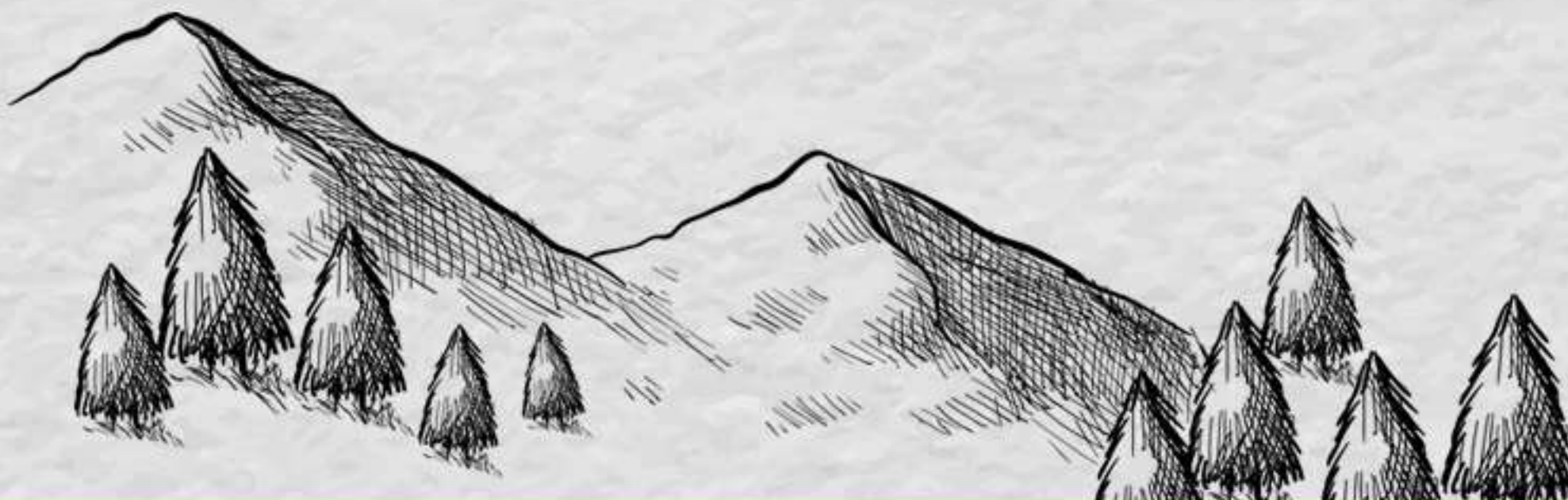


Day 5: DELHI ARRIVAL | TRIP END

- ▶ Reach Delhi early morning with lots of amazing memories and unforgettable experiences.

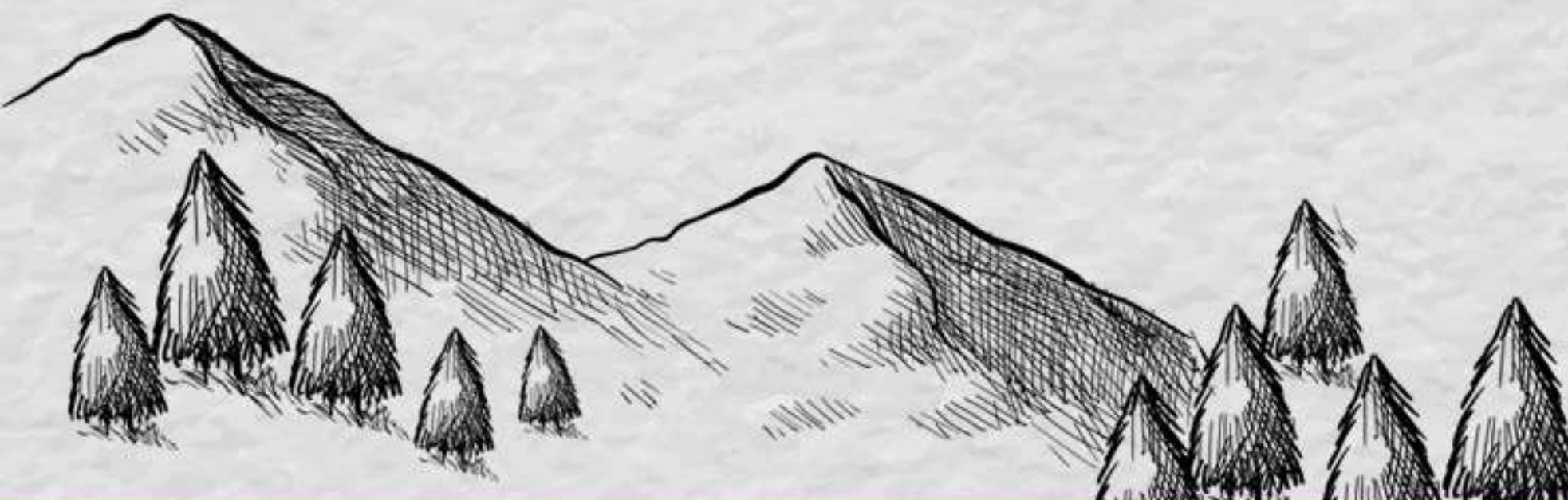
INCLUSIONS

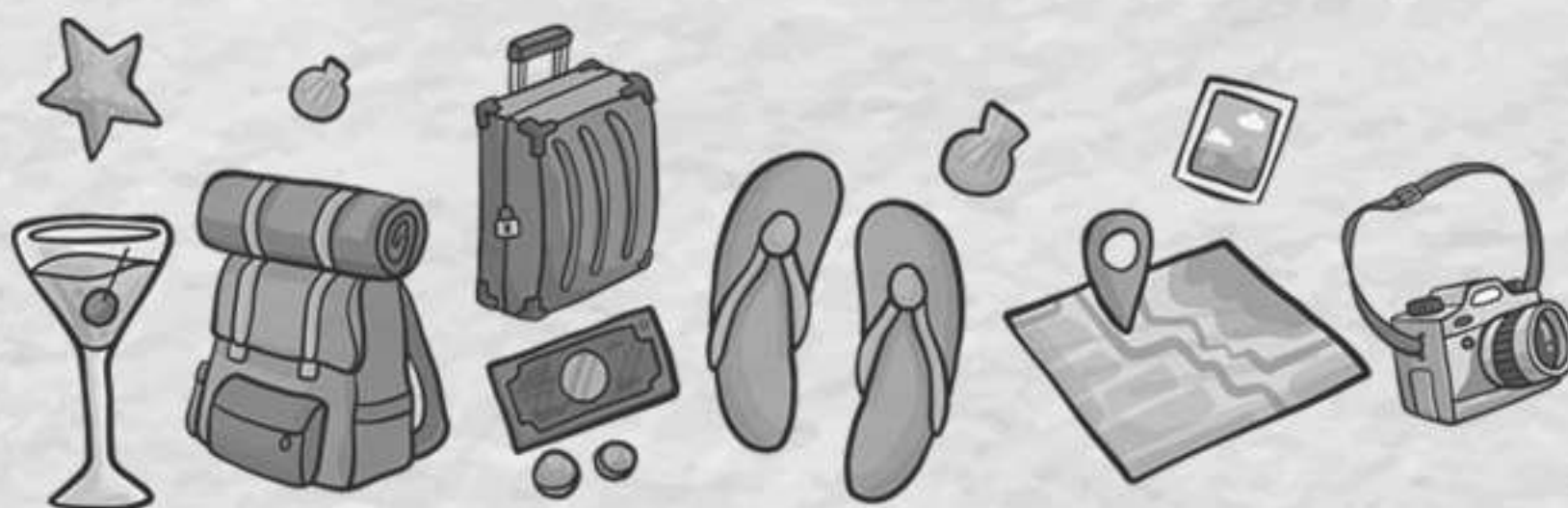

CANCELLATION

Policy

- Free Cancellation up to 60 days before the departure date (Booking amount is non-refundable)
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 59 days to 45 days of the Departure Date then only 10% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 44 Days to 30 Days of the Departure Date then only 25% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 29 Days to 15 Days of the Departure Date then only 50% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 15 Days to 8 Days of the Departure Date then only 75% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 7 Days from the Departure Date then 100% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded. You are not applicable for a refund if you fail to show up on the day of departure under the given timeline that has been provided to you beforehand.

- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 7 Days from the Departure Date then 100% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded. You are not applicable for a refund if you fail to show up on the day of departure under the given timeline that has been provided to you beforehand.
- There would be no refund provided in case there occur some problems due to government orders, harsh weather conditions, protests, landslides, or any other unforeseen circumstances. On the occasion of any such happenings, we have a backup plan ready most of the time and we'll be moving onto that.
- There are times when we would have to cancel some activities mentioned in the itinerary but it's only due to the reason that we would be bound by a circumstance that is not in our control.
- If a trek is called off at the last moment due to a natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc.) then the participants would be provided with a travel voucher for the same amount that can be used within 365 days of the issuance date for any package worth the same amount.
- If a trek/trip has to be aborted midway due to a natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc). In that case, no refund would be provided.
- EnLive Trips will not bear any extra expense due to any natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc).
