DETAILED *Itinerary*



Day 0: Delhi to Manali (Overnight Journey)

- ▶ Begin your adventure with an evening departure from **Kashmiri Gate**, Delhi. **Meet your Trip Captain** and fellow travelers before boarding the overnight vehicle to **Manali**.

Distance: Approx. 520 km

Travel Time: 12–14 Hours



Day 1: Arrival in Manali | Acclimatization & Local Exploration

- Reach Manali and check in to your hotel. Spend the day relaxing and acclimatizing to the mountain environment. In the evening, **Self-explore Manali** at your own pace. Visit attractions such as **Mall Road, Club House, Old Manali**, and nearby **cafés**.

Overnight Stay: Manali



Day 2: Manali to Chandratal Lake

- After an early breakfast, check out and drive through the **iconic Atal Tunnel** towards the rugged landscapes of Lahaul and Spiti. Reach the stunning **Chandratal Lake**. Enjoy the breathtaking scenery, **camp stay**, **bonfire**, and unforgettable **stargazing experience**.

Distance: Approx. 120 km

Travel Time: 5–6 Hours

Overnight Stay: Chandratal Camps



Day 3: Chandratal to Kaza

- Wake up early to witness the magical sunrise at **Chandratal**. Later, drive towards **Kaza via Kunzum Pass** and **Chicham Bridge**, one of Asia's highest suspension bridges. En route, visit the famous **Key Monastery** and soak in panoramic views of Spiti Valley.

Distance: Approx. 100 km

Travel Time: 5–6 Hours

Overnight Stay: Kaza



Day 4: Hikkim - Komic - Langza Excursion

- Explore the highest inhabited villages of the world. Visit Hikkim, home to **the world's highest post office**, Komic, one of the highest motorable villages, and Langza, famous for its giant **Buddha statue** and marine fossils. Return to Kaza and spend the evening exploring the **local market**.

Distance: Approx. 50 km (Round Trip)

Travel Time: 3 - 4 Hours

Overnight Stay: Kaza



Day 5: Kaza to Nako / Khab

- ▶ After breakfast, begin your journey towards Nako. Visit the ancient **Dhankar Monastery** perched dramatically on a cliff, followed by **Tabo Monastery**. Explore the historic **Tabo Caves** and the mysterious **Gue Monastery**, famous for its naturally preserved mummy.

Distance: Approx. 115 km

Travel Time: 5-6 Hours

Overnight Stay: Nako / Khab



Day 6: Nako to Chitkul

- ▶ Start your day with a visit to the beautiful **Nako Lake**. Continue towards **Khab Sangam**, where the Spiti and Sutlej rivers meet. Stop at the famous **Roghi Suicide Point** for breathtaking valley views before entering the scenic **Baspa Valley**. Arrive at Chitkul, the last inhabited village near the **Indo-Tibet border**.

Distance: Approx. 105 km

Travel Time: 5-6 Hours

Overnight Stay: Chitkul



Day 7: Chitkul to Shimla | Overnight Journey to Delhi

- Enjoy the serene beauty of Chitkul in the morning before driving through **Sangla Valley**, Rampur, and **Shimla**. Board the overnight vehicle for Delhi.

Distance: Approx. 250 km (Chitkul to Shimla)

Travel Time: 8-9 Hours

Overnight Stay: Shimla to Delhi



Day 8: Arrival in Delhi

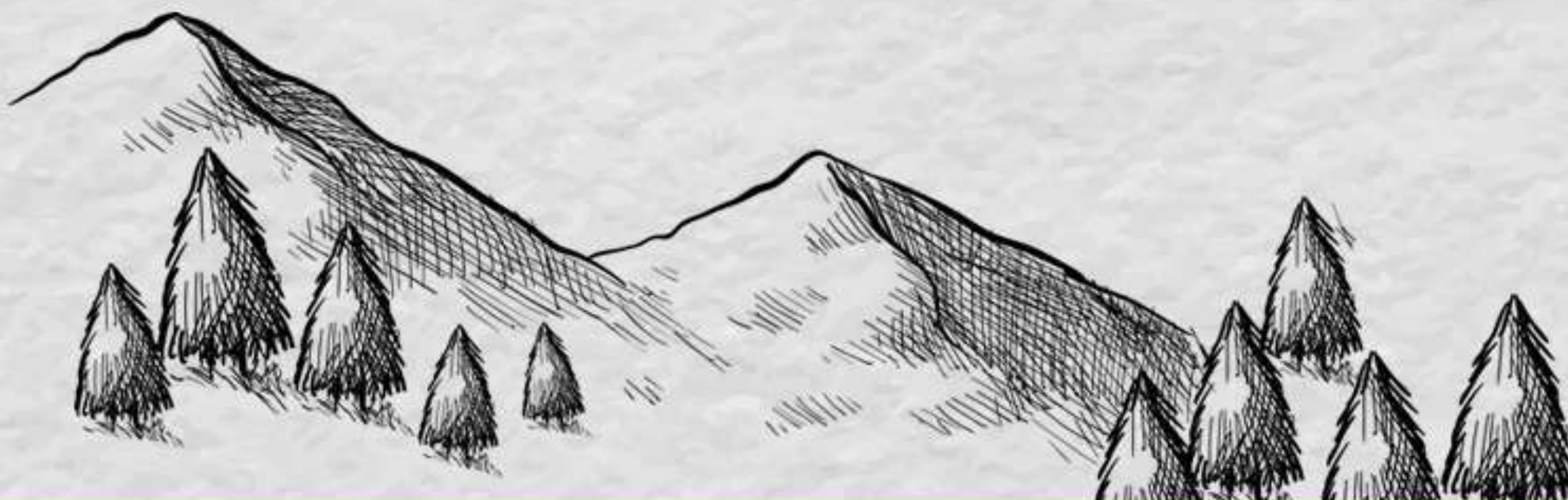
- Reach Delhi in the morning with unforgettable memories of Spiti Valley's dramatic landscapes, ancient monasteries, pristine lakes, and high-altitude villages.

Distance: Approx. 350 km

Travel Time: 8–9 Hours

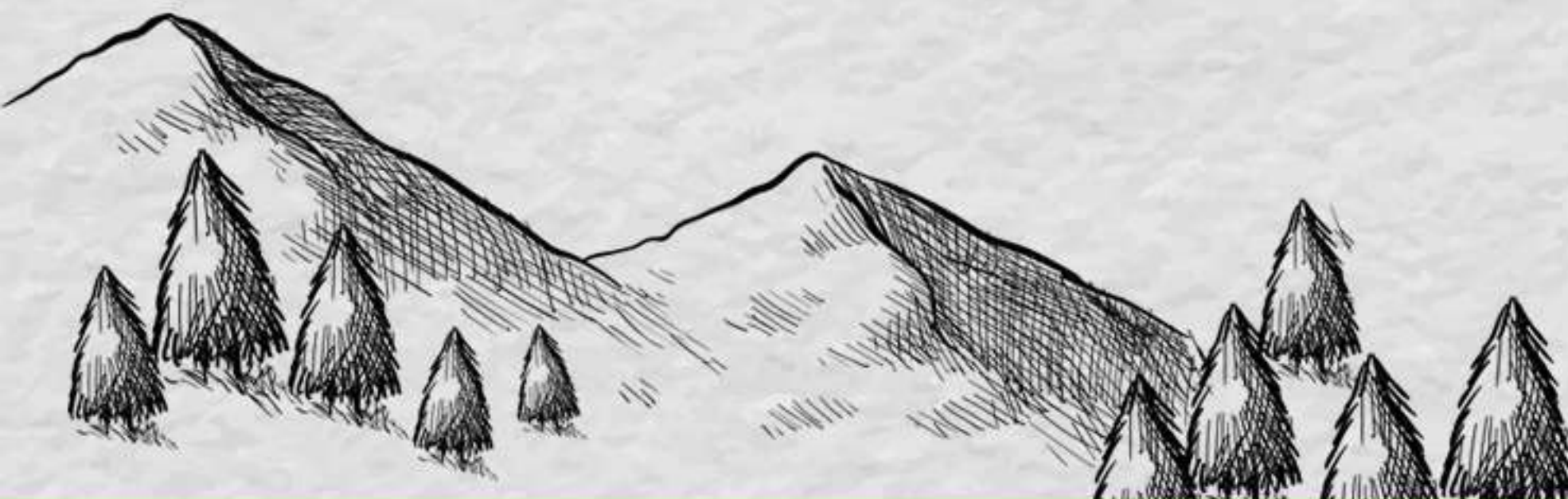

Notes

- ⦿ Respect the local culture and customs: Spiti Valley is home to diverse cultures and traditions. Be respectful and ask for permission before taking photos of people or their property.
- ⦿ Carry warm clothing: Spiti can get very cold, even in summer. Pack warm clothing, including layers and thermal wear. Bring -10°C winter down jacket with you.
- ⦿ Stay hydrated: Drink plenty of water to avoid altitude sickness. Carry a refillable water bottle.
- ⦿ Network connectivity: Jio, Airtel and BSNL works the best but if you have VI sim it will stop working on the first day itself.
- ⦿ Dry Washroom: In winters due to extreme cold, water becomes a luxury asset so in that case dry washroom is used.
- ⦿ There can be road closures during the course of the trip, any cost due to that will not be paid by the company.
- ⦿ Plan for emergencies: Spiti is secluded, so carry basic medical supplies or your ongoing medicines. Our trip captain will also be carrying first aid box and oxygen can.
- ⦿ Don't litter: Dispose of your trash properly and avoid leaving any waste behind.
- ⦿ Don't disturb wildlife: Spiti has unique flora and fauna; do not disrupt the local wildlife.
- ⦿ Don't engage in disrespectful behavior: Avoid any actions that may offend the local population or fellow travelers.
- ⦿ Don't expect modern amenities: Spiti is remote, infrastructure is basic and raw in nature, so don't expect the same level of comfort or luxury as in urban areas.



CANCELLATION

Policy

- Free Cancellation up to 60 days before the departure date (Booking amount is non-refundable)
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 59 days to 45 days of the Departure Date then only 10% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (nonrefundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 44 Days to 30 Days of the Departure Date then only 25% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (nonrefundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 29 Days to 15 Days of the Departure Date then only 50% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (nonrefundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 15 Days to 8 Days of the Departure Date then only 75% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (nonrefundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 7 Days from the Departure Date then 100% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded. You are not applicable for a refund if you fail to show up on the day of departure under the given timeline that has been provided to you beforehand.

- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 7 Days from the Departure Date then 100% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded. You are not applicable for a refund if you fail to show up on the day of departure under the given timeline that has been provided to you beforehand.
- There would be no refund provided in case there occur some problems due to government orders, harsh weather conditions, protests, landslides, or any other unforeseen circumstances. On the occasion of any such happenings, we have a backup plan ready most of the time and we'll be moving onto that.
- There are times when we would have to cancel some activities mentioned in the itinerary but it's only due to the reason that we would be bound by a circumstance that is not in our control.
- If a trek is called off at the last moment due to a natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc.) then the participants would be provided with a travel voucher for the same amount that can be used within 365 days of the issuance date for any package worth the same amount.
- If a trek/trip has to be aborted midway due to a natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc). In that case, no refund would be provided.
- EnLive Trips will not bear any extra expense due to any natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc).
- Cancellations policy differs for popular destinations and also during peak season, kindly confirm with your operator once.
